SCHOOL EXCURSION OPPORTUNITIES PREP TO YEAR 2

Your class will step back in time at this friendly township museum showcasing the rich, colourful history of the Rockhampton district 1850 – 1950.



We can customise your tour to suit your group's requirements. Some tour options we offer include:

Tram Rides. All aboard the Heritage Village tram for your journey back to the olden days. Originally a horse-drawn vehicle, our tram has been adapted for use with a tractor.

Rosewood Homestead. How did the pioneers of the region live? Visit Rosewood Homestead and find out. Have a look around. It's quite different to your house today. Where are the light switches; taps for water; and where does the water come from? Why is there a dirt floor in the kitchen and where is the plug for the bath? Students are encouraged to look around and noticed the differences and maybe even find some objects that are still in use today.

Lakes Creek Cottage. Bring your students to see how their grandparents lived. This cottage, known as a 'worker's cottage' is more than 100 years old.

Check out the wood heater in the bathroom for heating water to pour directly into the bathtub and the kitchen has 'mod cons', like a refrigerator, enamel pots and a gas stove etc. How different is this cottage to your home?

Vintage Cars The Heritage Village has a sizeable collection of vintage cars on display. Our volunteers would be only too happy to take your students for a ride in one. How different is it to their family car?

Charles Street Fire Station. Visit our Fire Station and see our display of fire-fighting memorabilia. Our resident 'firey', if requested, can be on hand to help the children try some of the uniforms and to talk about fire safety.

Farmyard Animal Experience. Our farmyard animal experience is great for younger visitors and is available on request. Students can hand-feed different breeds of goats and sheep.
