Our signature dry hire package is perfect for large weddings and events. It includes a set up day for preparations plus a day after to enjoy your event and pack up the day after.

- Use of the Shearing Shed from 9.00am on the day of the hire until 12.00am plus additional complimentary set up and pack down days (either side of your event between 10am and 3pm)
- Use of bar for your bar service provider
- Use of the commercial kitchen for your caterers
- A choice of 180cm round or 240cm rectangular tables (25 of each available) set in place as per the decided floor plan
- Chairs and tables set in place (chair covers and table clothes available from local suppliers)
- PA system with 2 cordless microphones for announcements, background music and speeches
- Use of the projectors and screens for the duration of your function
- Use of lectern, wine barrels and market barrows for function
- Use of the Shearing Shed Functions WIFI
- Use of the courtyard area
- Heritage village ceremony location included with 30 outdoor chairs, arch, and signing table with two chairs for bride and groom

STRINGYBARK YARDS

Stringybark Yards is our most popular wedding ceremony location. This versatile location provides wedding guests with multiple options for set up with beautiful leafy or rustic homestead backdrops. The area caters comfortably for 150 guests.

This location is beautifully shaded during the afternoon, ideal for 2:30/3:00pm ceremonies.

THE CHURCH

An early 20th century country church, capable of seating a congregation of 72. With direct access to the Heritage Village for packaged themed events.

The Church is ideally suited for weddings, christenings, naming ceremonies, commemorative services.

ROSEWOOD HOMESTEAD

Originally built in the 1800's this slab house shows the workmanship of times gone by featuring thick slab walls and rustic veranda in a garden setting.

RACKEMANN'S COTTAGE

Rackemann's Cottage was donated by the Rackemann family, originally from Wooroolin in 1908. In 1996, Rackemann's Cottage was relocated to the Heritage Village where it showcases living conditions from late 1800's to early 1900's, without electricity and where washing was done using chip copper and galvanised wash tubs.

Rackemann's is ideally suited for smaller and intimate occasions.

PHOTO LOCATIONS

Photographic locations in historic or bush settings are available through the Heritage Village.

- Photography onsite is included in all ceremony venue packages up to 4pm. Combined ceremony & reception packages include photography onsite until 6pm.
- Photography onsite without a booking, incurs a \$5 per person entry fee until 4pm. After 4pm, a fee of \$200 per hour or part thereof applies.
- All cars must have exited the village by 4pm unless prior arrangements have been made.

Booking

We want to make sure our venue is the perfect place to hold your event.

Here are a few things to consider when booking a wedding at the Heritage Village.

DRY HIRE

We are a 'dry hire' venue. This means that you are fully responsible for the hire, set up, pack up and clean up of the venue. On the first day of your booking, we will arrange a meeting with you and run you through the venue.

Dry hire gives you the flexibility to engage your favourite suppliers including catering, DJ, Bar Service. It also provides you with the flexibility to do your own styling based on your unique taste. Discuss with your decorator, caterer and bar vendor about organising cutlery, crockery and glassware or these can be sourced from local party supply vendors.

CURFEW

We have a strict curfew time of midnight for all functions. Your last call for drinks should be not later than 11:30pm, with last service strictly at 11:45pm.

CEREMONY

We recommend that you pre-arrange a styling company or friends and family to set up your ceremony at least two hours in advance to ensure enough time for last minute changes and trouble shooting.

Winter ceremonies are recommended for 2:30pm.

Summer ceremonies are recommended for 3:00pm.

Following your ceremony, guests should be ushered to the courtyard of the Shearing Shed (we recommend you line up your MC to do this job). Talk to your catering and bar staff about serving drinks and nibbles during this time while the Bride and Groom go off to take photos. Please note that no alcohol is allowed to be consumed within the Heritage Village, only in the Shearing Shed area. The Heritage Village is open to the public until 4pm. All vehicles must be outside of the Village gates by 4pm

TASKS FOR YOUR MC

Your MC should be someone who is available to meet with our staff on the day before your function to run through the duties of the MC including use of the equipment, trouble shooting tips and tricks plus important announcements – toilets, evacuation routes etc.

KEEPING US IN THE LOOP



PAYMENT

To secure your booking, we ask for a \$1000 security bond upon booking. Full payment must be made 10 days prior to the function.
